a. Prosecuting Attorney's Office - Update on Caseload and Recent Arrests

Cindy Brown, Chief Prosecuting Attorney, and Undersheriff Timothy Willis, Sheriff's Office, provided an update on current caseloads and recent arrests. It was reported that two (2) additional cases have been charged. As a follow-up from the last meeting, Brown reported that approximately a minimum of 184 victims have been helped. Nuisance abatement letters will be sent to the property owners of the top twelve (12) properties receiving a complaint. Recipients will have forty-five (45) days to remove the business. After forty-five (45) days, investigators will go check on the properties. If the business is still in operation, a civil lawsuit will be filed.
