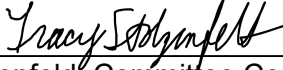

Powell moved to receive and file the PowerPoint presentation regarding fair housing initiatives. Seconded by McGillivray.

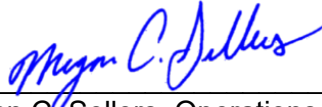
Motion carried.
